Applicant Requirements:

- At least 18 years of age and less than 35 years of age, OR within the requirements set by Police & Fire Retirement System (PFRS).
- United States citizenship AND reside in New Jersey at the time of appointment.
- A High School diploma/equivalent.
- A valid New Jersey driver's license.
- A New Jersey Police Training Commission Basic Police Class A Certification, OR
- Be currently enrolled in a New Jersey Certified Police Academy (basic police class A), OR
- Be a New Jersey Certified Special Law Enforcement Officer (SLEO) Class II and meet the requirements set by the New Jersey Police Training Commission to be eligible for a waiver. **Corrections Officer Certifications do not qualify for this process.**

Preferred Qualifications (not mandatory):

- Previous law enforcement or military experience.
- Associate's or Bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice or related field.
- Bilingual abilities.

The Applicant must pass psychological, medical, and drug testing, have excellent communication and interpersonal skills, as well as read, write, and speak the English language, should be of good moral character, good physical condition, and not convicted of any crime/offense.
